


Game 1: Badge of Knowledge

Task: Correctly identify the 3 steps you should take in order. 1,2,3.




Call 911 or your local emergency number right away!

The Good Samaritan Drug Overdose Act is a law that protects people who seek help during an overdose. The Act aims to reduce the fear of getting in trouble if police respond to an overdose (even if you have taken a drug or have some on you) and encourages people to help save a life.






